Description of Project:

World Vision Pakistan's operational plan until September 2010 was mainly focused on Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Aiming at ong-term programming WVP identified strategic areas in Sindh Baluchistan, Punjab and NWFP based on human levelopment indicators. In the process of exploring new areas of programming and target provinces where WV can work in collaboration with government and community to respond to issues on health, education, governance and child rights through its programming. WV conducted a rapid need assessment in four union councils of Nathia Gali with the overall objective of need analysis on programming options in gender, education, health, nutrition, child rights, numanitarian protection and governance in the district of Abbottabad.

WVP is planning to respond to the health needs in the most vulnerable rural communities of Nathia Dali UC in Abbottabad district. It will do this through empowering communities in advocacy for improving health services for women and children. WVP will use the household to hospital continuum of care model to establish and support community based networks, linked with adjacent health facilities that serve the area. Each community will establish men and women health committees with representatives from different casts/class, geographical areas and age groups. Heads of each committee will be members of a district/UC health management team. The Communities will advocate for improved GOP accountability in infrastructure repair, mountainous areas service provision and management. WVP will support the District/Tehsil Health management team in terms of mobility, capacity building in supportive supervision, community involvement and team work.
